Morris County Colonials Tryout Dates Announced

The Morris County Colonials announced open tryout dates ahead of the 2009 National Premier Soccer League (NPSL) season. The Morristown-based team are the Northern New Jersey representatives of the NPSL, representing the highest level of amateur soccer in the United States.

Tryouts will be Friday December 19th and Monday January 12th both 7-9pm at Millburn High School. Tryouts are the first step to representing the local Morristown area at the highest amateur level in the Nation. With considerable interest already from players across the area, the 2009 season promises to be an exciting one for Colonials, entering their second season in the NPSL.

The 2008 campaign saw the Colonials endure a difficult start to life in the NPSL, competing in the tough North Eastern Division against established teams such as Boston Aztecs and the eventual National Champions, the Pennsylvania Stoners. A change of Head coach and management team led to a change of fortunes as the Colonials improved tremendously in the second half of the season, losing by just one goal to the Stoners in their penultimate game.

The Colonials and Head Coach Rob Alman are looking forward to the upcoming campaign with great anticipation. "Our performances at the end of last season were encouraging; we are looking to build on our strong finish and push to compete for a place in the playoffs this season" comments Alman. The Colonials hope to add top college players to their roster to join those from the 2008 campaign already playing at the top level. Monmouth University, UMass and South Carolina State were amongst the colleges represented by the Colonials in their inaugural campaign.
